Model Mitigation Plan Checklist

- Called for in the Mitigation Action Plan
- Purpose:
 - Facilitate submission of required information by permit applicants early in the process
 - Allow more effective participation and project review during public notice
 - Minimize delays in the permit decision-making process

Components of Checklist:

- 1. Mitigation Goals and Objectives
- 2. Baseline Information for Impact Site and Proposed Mitigation Site
- 3. Mitigation Site Selection and Justification
- 4. Mitigation Work Plan

Components of Checklist:

- 5. Performance Standards
- 6. Site Protection and Maintenance
- 7. Monitoring Plan
- 8. Adaptive Management Plan
- 9. Financial Assurance

Adapt NRC Mitigation Guidelines

- 1. Consider the hydrogeomorphic, ecological landscape, and climate.
- 2. Adopt a dynamic landscape perspective.
- 3. Restore/develop a naturally variable hydrological conditions.
- 4. Choose wetland restoration over creation.
- 5. Avoid over-engineered structures.
- 6. Attention to appropriate planting elevation, depth, soil type, and seasonal timing.
- 7. Provide heterogeneous topography.
- 8. Attention to subsurface conditions:
- 9. Consider complications with working in degraded or disturbed sites.
- 10. Conduct monitoring as part of adaptive management.

Adapt NRC Mitigation Guidelines

- Organized the 10 guidelines into two categories:
 - Basic requirements for Success
 - Mitigation Site Selection
- Added supplementary text to aid regulators in interpreting and implementing guidelines
- Goal: Integrate into Section 404 Program

District Mitigation Guidelines

- Mitigation and Monitoring Guidelines in all 38 Corps Districts
 - Public Notices December 2003
 - Finalize by June 2004
- Provided 15 examples for Districts to use as models
- District Guidelines include completed MAP work products:
 - Model Mitigation Plan Checklist [2003]
 - Adaptation of NRC Guidelines to CWA Section 404
 Program [2003]

Status of District Web Postings

To date:

- 24 Districts Posted Checklists and Guidance
- 2 States (Texas and Arkansas) given extensions to complete consolidated checklists with the states
