

Juge Gregg is an attorney in the Law and Policy Section of the Environment and Natural Resources Section of the Department of Justice. Previously, he served as a senior associate in Sidley Austin's environmental group where he advised clients on a broad range of environmental, natural resources, and international environmental laws.
