

Women on Boards



- 99% of corporate boards are majority male*
- Women make up approximately 20% of the directors of U.S. boards* 18.5% of Russell 3000 companies**
- Representation differs by sectors*
 25% for utilities, lowest for energy companies
 - Correlation with rates of women CEOs
- Mandatory board gender diversity requirements: Germany, Norway, France, Spain, Iceland, Netherlands***
- California Senate Bill 826, signed into law Sept. 2018***
