 - Hazardous Air Pollutants
 - Federal Enforcement
 - Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality
 - Plan Requirements for Nonattainment Areas
- Title II - Emission Standards for Moving Sources
- Title III - General Provisions
 - Includes definitions and citizen suit process
- Title IV - Acid Deposition Control
- Title V - [Operating] Permits
- Title VI - Stratospheric Ozone Protection

Major Clean Air Act Programs

- Federal New Source Review (NSR) Preconstruction Permits
